Main Duties:

Working within the Marine Division initially, this role will focus on the execution of a key project primarily involving corrosion protection. Teams primarily consist of industrial painters and blasters engaged in high risk activities. The role involves all stages of project execution, client liaison and also planning for new work being tendered. Typically this would include:

- Project documentation including Project Management Plan, Risk Register and HSEQ Plans
- Maintaining production records against budget and schedule
- Meeting project reporting requirements
- Performance managing project teams
- Subcontractor performance and compliance
- Compliance with Site and Company Safety standards
- Coordinate program and technical interface requirements
- Provide advice to Project Engineers and Supervisors on work method, technology and environmental monitoring
- Establish project targets and achieve deliverables

Qualifications:

Skills/Experience:

- Minimum 6 years' experience as a Project Manager or similar obtained ideally in defence or marine.
- Ideally experience in industrial services such as protective coatings, glass reinforced plastics, concrete rehabilitation, waterproofing or a similar area.
- Subcontractor engagement and management skills.
- Contract management skills - meeting deliverables, managing variations and planning work activities.
- Experience assisting with tenders, developing work method statements, budgets and tracking productivity.
- Intermediate skills in Microsoft Excel, Word and Outlook.
- Possess a General Construction White Card or equivalent.
- Experienced with confined space operations.
